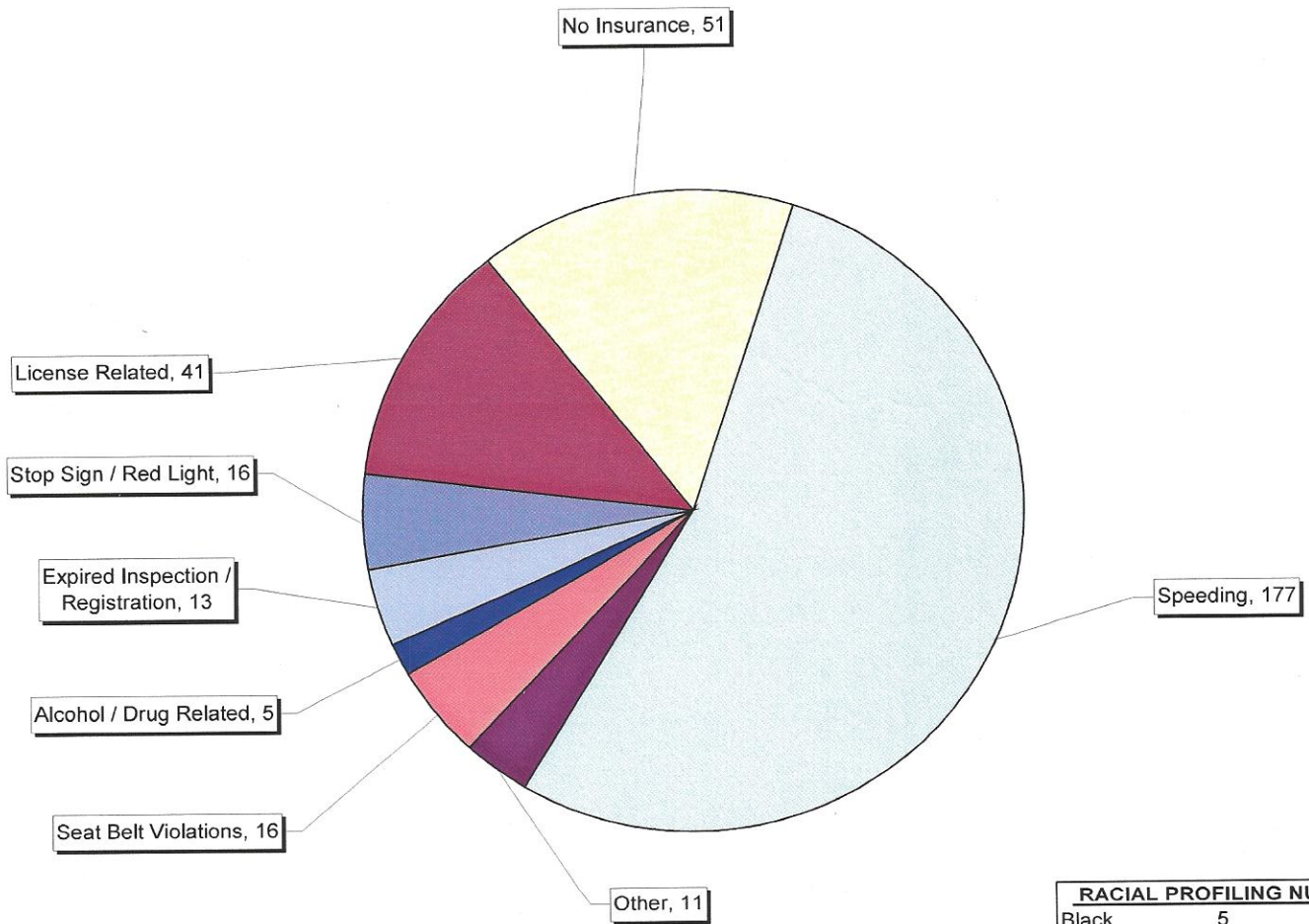
Special & Significant Events / Investigations/ Activities / Misc. Information
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- **Fire Marshal update:** Results are pending on are Fire Inspection exam we took on Feb. 6. If the results are good I should be able to submit our applications to the Texas Commission on Fire Protection for both our Arson Investigator and Fire Inspector certifications. I believe we will have an agenda item next month regarding the adoption of an updated model fire code.
- **Civilian Auxiliary update:** We have a meeting planned for Feb. 19 at 6:30 pm. We have already had numerous ride-a-longs, which is part of the initial training phase. Right now we have 18 members with a handful of applications still out.
- **Seizure Fund update:** We received \$956.37 from the Atascosa Co. Dist. Atty.'s Office. This was our share of some cash seized during arrest Ofc. Hanson had. I will use this money for equipment or training as authorized by Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedures.
