

Minutes of Mobile Home Commission Meeting held February 1, 2021

Mobile Home Commission meeting with the following present: Mobile Home Commission members Elisa Grothues, Troy Whitney, Lynn Anderson, Donna Hendrick.

Visitors: Josie Campa, Guadalupe Rios, Mark Urrutia.

Mobile Home Commission Chairman Donna Hendrick called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and announced the purpose of the hearing was to consider the request from Mark Urrutia to place a double-wide mobile home on his property on N. Benton Street.

The Chairman asked City Secretary Josie Campa if she had heard from any of the neighboring property owners on this request.

The City Secretary told the Commission she had not heard anything pro or con, on this request. She told the Commission that several years ago, the applicant's mother had a double-wide mobile home on this property and had moved it. She told the Commission that Mr. Urrutia's mother had gotten permission a few years ago to move another home onto this lot, but never did. She said the property has now been deeded to Mr. Urrutia.

Guadalupe Rios told Commission members that he has the property next door and he has no objections as long as all the requirements are met.

Troy Whitney made the motion that the Commission recommend to Council that placement of this mobile home be approved. Seconded by Lynn Anderson. Passed unanimously.
