Council discussed items needing attention and the Mayor told Council about getting junk vehicles off the City right-of-ways. Other items in need of attention are junk vehicles on lots and yards; lots and yards that have debris and are considered health hazards.




Council discussed the need for a hazardous waste material cleanup. The City Secretary will look into this matter and report back to Council at the October meeting.
